## February 17, 2025

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Potter Valley Irrigation District was called to order by Vice President Janet Pauli @ 1:01 pm at the Potter Valley Irrigation District Office

**Public Comment:** Vice President Janet Pauli will chair this meeting in the absence of President Ken Stroh.

Oath of Office was taken by Directors Magruder, McMenomey and Mcfadden.

#### **Minutes:**

Dir. Magruder made a motion to approve the January Regular Meeting Minutes and Dir. McMenomey seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**Check Register:** The January check register totaling \$126,149.86 and the unpaid bills totaling \$8593.60 were reviewed;

Dir. MmMenomy made a motion that the unpaid bills be approved for payment, Dir. McFadden seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**Financial Report:** Report was reviewed, discussed and accepted.

**Assessor/Collector's Report:** Assessor/Collector Boatwright prepared a report with the following information, discussion was had:

**Superintendent's Report:** The Superintendent's Report as written and delivered was discussed. Board discussed issues at gate #58. Directors discussed taking a Board fieldtrip to view gate issues. Superintendent found 60inch culvert piping tubes, with 5 sections of 20ft tubes at \$2000 each. Board discussed purchasing 5 tubes. Dir McFadden motions to purchase 5 20ft tubes; Dir Magruder 2nds the motion. Motion passes unanimously.

Superintendent Brown discussed entering into service agreement with Peterson Cat for newly purchased excavator. Initial cost would be about \$3000 to initiate contract; with subsequent services being paid as received.

- 2. **Mendocino County Inland Water & Power Commission Report:** Dir. Pauli reported:
  - MCIWPC continues negotiations with PG&E.
  - PV Project will have diversion infrastructure; referred to as new Eel/ Russian Facility at NERF.
  - Currently a non binding MOU has been put into place, a final binding water diversion agreement will be finalized and filed with FERC when PGE completes their final liscense surrender application.
- 3. Status Report on PG&E / PVID Contract discussions with Seth Perez:

Dir. Pauli and Superintendent Brown are working on getting crop info for license amendment; requesting an adjustment for this situation. Ag Commissioner Goodwin spoke in regards to commodities report; has completed 2022, working on getting 2023 numbers together. Goodwin working on offering Board a Potter Valley Specific report within a few weeks.
