**NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. Discussion of FERC's approval of PG&E's license variance request and reduction of diversion deliveries to PVID:** The PVID Board of Directors discussed the impacts of an abrupt decrease in water flows by PG&E after the FERC variance approval. PG&E suggests an average of 20cubic feet per second and stated PVID only had 2800 acre feet still available. Don Brown spoke to Seth Perez who agreed that PVID should be able to use an average of 25 cubic feet per second and that there was no limit.  
Superintendent Brown is currently tracking the daily use of water and working on attaining a 25cfs average use from now until the end of season in October.

There being no further business on the Agenda, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
